God the Creator or sole primal source of all things makes anything that becomes actual possible. Although anything that becomes actual is, in its way, also a creator and a source of *some* other things, whereby they become possible, God is *the* Creator or *sole primal* source, because God alone is the source of *all* things, and any other source likewise has God as *its* only primal source.

God the Consummator or sole final end of all things makes anything that becomes actual significant. Although anything that becomes actual is, in its way, also a consummator and an end of *some* other things, whereby they become significant, God is *the* Consummator or *sole final* end, because God alone is the end of *all* things, and any other end likewise has God as *its* only final end.
