On the Ministry

- 1. The basic distinction is between the *constitutive* and the *constituted* ministry—or between the ministry constitutive of the church and the ministry constituted by the church.
- 2. The second, constituted ministry, or ministry constituted by the church, is also appropriately called the *representative* ministry.
- 3. Consequently, there is the further distinction between the *constitutive* and the *representative* ministry.
