Experience, according to *Webster's Dictionary* (as quoted by Kenneth S. Davis in his *Experience of War*) is "actual living through an event or events; actual enjoyment or suffering."

"the common structure of all our experiences"

"the strictlty universal structures of reality which experience discloses"
